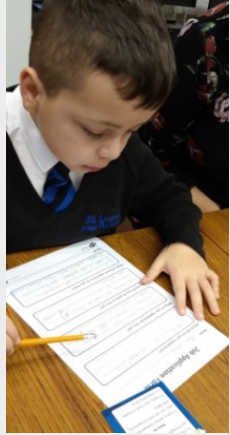


# Newsletter
