

Admissions Policy.

Admissions come directly to Damien Sweeney, Head of The Cornerstone Academy.

The process will begin with a telephone conversation about the child in question. Following this a school visit may take place to observe the child in class. From here, if a placement at The Cornerstone Academy is deemed appropriate, then referral forms will be sent to school and a home visit will take place. Referral forms need to demonstrate which strategies have been tried in the form of two 'Plan, Do, Review' cycles.

Once the home visit has taken place and parents/carers and school are in agreement and the referral form has been completed, then a start date can be agreed. Referral forms can be obtained by emailing Damien Sweeney-

Schools need to arrange transport to and from The Cornerstone Academy but do not need to supply additional support in the form of teaching assistants.

Once the placement has been agreed, a review and end date must also be agreed.

Once all of the above has been completed, the child can begin their placement at The Cornerstone Academy.
